At Wedmore Dental Practice, we understand that some of our patients may not be able to visit the practice due to immobility or health conditions. To ensure they continue to receive the care they need, we offer professional dental visits in the comfort of their own home, tailored to meet the individual needs of those who are considered housebound.

Our domiciliary service allows us to provide essential dental care in a safe, familiar environment, helping to reduce anxiety and inconvenience. We aim to deliver the same high standard of professional and compassionate care that patients would receive at the practice, ensuring comfort, dignity, and ongoing support for their oral health.



Our Vision

At Wedmore Dental Practice our vision is to ‘*Share our passion for health*’ and our reputation is built on providing personalised care for every patient.

The Practice Principal, Jennifer Morecroft, has long recognised the lack of domiciliary dental care provision in Somerset.

As a team we are passionate about healthcare and we observe the impact that poor oral health can have on general health outcomes.

Dental Care @ Home

We are pleased to introduce Dental Care @ Home, bringing private dentistry to the comfort of your own home.

Domiciliary care will be available on Tuesdays, provided by our associate Dr Agata Milewicz, to patients located within our home-visit service area.

Agata has extensive experience in dental care. In addition to working at our practice, she also serves as a Clinical Supervisor at the Bristol Dental School, where she has a special interest in paediatric and special care dentistry.

Agata will be assisted by one of our domiciliary-trained dental nurses.

Dental Treatments Available @ Home



General exams and cleaning



Simple extractions



Basic fillings and dressings



Oral and denture hygiene instruction, including supply of toothbrushes, tooth paste and other cleaning aids



Construction of new dentures and other denture work: repairs, additions and adjustments



Fillings & Smoothing of sharp teeth



Fluoride varnish application to treat decay and sensitivity



How to Arrange Your appointment

To arrange a home visit, you can enquire by phone, email, or letter. When registering your interest, please ensure you include your telephone number.

Our reception team will contact you by phone and ask a few questions to confirm that the domiciliary service is suitable for your needs and you live within home-visit service area.

Once we have this information, one of our nurses will contact you by phone to discuss your home setup, support needs, and treatment requirements in more detail.

Agata, the dentist, will then review your details and plan the necessary equipment for your visit.

What to Expect During your Visit

Our domiciliary dental team will arrive at your home with all the necessary equipment. Once your treatment is complete, the team will safely dispose of any hazardous waste and sharps.

If any items in your home were moved to accommodate our equipment, they will be returned to their original positions.

During the appointment, the dentist will discuss your treatment options and provide a clear explanation of the associated fees. Once a treatment plan is agreed, you will be asked to sign the plan, which will include estimated costs. We will always listen to your preferences and expectations; we have a lot of experience tailoring treatment plans to accommodate individual needs and budgets.

We also encourage patients to have a friend or family member present for support and comfort during the appointment.



Examinations & Fees

New Patient Examinations

If you are new to the practice or have not been seen by one of our dentists within the last 2 years, you will require a new patient dental examination at home:

- **Band A radius:** £320
- **Band B radius:** £405

Routine Patient Examination

For patients who have been seen within the last 2 years and only require a routine examination:

- **Band A radius:** £286.20
- **Band B radius:** £371.20



What is included

As part of our home visiting service, we offer an examination package which includes:

- A comprehensive dental assessment.
- Two x-rays
- An Attendance fee

The attendance fee covers the additional costs of providing dental care in your home, including travel, portable equipment, and staff time.

If you live just outside the Band A or Band B radius, home visits may still be possible; however, a higher attendance fee is likely to apply.

Our reception team will be happy to review your address, confirm which band you fall under, and advise you of the applicable fees before your appointment is booked.

Treatments & Additional Fees

Following your examination, if any further treatment is required, your dentist will provide a detailed treatment plan and explain any additional costs.

You will be asked to sign the treatment plan to confirm you are happy to proceed and to authorise our dental team to carry out the treatment.

Our reception team will then contact you within 24 hours after your visit to arrange payment for any additional treatment provided.

Payment Arrangements

Once you contact our reception team to request a home visit, one of our dental nurses will carry out a brief assessment over the phone to discuss your dental needs.

After this assessment, and when you agree to proceed with a home visit examination, payment for the examination will be taken in advance before your appointment is booked.

Please note: Any additional treatment provided during your visit will be charged separately. Payment for additional treatment will be taken 24 hours after your appointment, either by card over the phone with our reception team or via bank transfer.

When making payments via bank transfer please include the name of the person who the payment is for so we can ensure payment is allocated correctly.

Care & Residential Homes

For visits to care homes or residential settings where multiple residents are seen during the same visit, travel costs are shared, helping to reduce individual expenses.

Each additional resident will incur a attendance fee of £110, with the total fee divided equally among all residents to ensure fairness.

Examination fees and any necessary treatments are charged separately, on top of the attendance fee.
